

# I . 연혁

History

## 1. 연혁

음성은 일찍이 진국(辰國)의 땅이었고 삼한시대(三韓時代)는 마한(馬韓)에 속하여 그 50여국 가운데 지침국(支侵國)에 속하여 있었다.

삼국시대에는 잉홀현(仍忽縣)이라 부르고 처음에는 노음죽현(奴音竹縣 : 현 경기도 이천시 장호원을 선읍리)에 속하였으며 그후 금물노군(今勿奴郡 : 현 진천)에 속하여 있었다.

- 661~680** 신라 문무왕때 서원경(西原京 : 현 청주)에 속한 잉홀현
- 757.** 신라 경덕왕 16년 흑양군(黑攘郡 : 현 진천군)에 속한 음성현(陰城縣)으로 개칭
- 995.** 고려 성종 14년 중원도 충주부 음성현
- 1356.** 고려 공민왕 5년 양광도 충주부 음성현
- 1598.** 조선 선조 31년 청안현으로 폐현
- 1618.** 조선 광해군 18년 음성현으로 복현(復縣)
- 1662.** 조선 현종 3년 괴산군에 병합 폐현
- 1663.** 조선 현종 4년 음성현으로 복현
- 1895. 5.26.** 칙령(勅令) 제98호로 음성군이라 칭함.
- 1914. 3. 1.** 부령(府令) 제111호(1913.12.29. 공포)에 의한 부군면(府君面)의 폐합으로 충주군 소이면, 금왕면, 생극면, 대소면, 맹동면, 삼성면, 감곡면이 편입되어 9개면이 됨.
- 1956. 7. 8.** 법률 제393호(1956.7.8. 공포)로 음성면을 읍으로 승격(1읍 8면)
- 1973. 7. 1.** 대통령령 제6542호(1973.12.12.공포)로 생극면 도신리 일부를 금왕면으로 편입하고 중원군 신니면 광월리 부수마을 일부를 음성읍으로 괴산군 불정면 문등리를 소이면에 편입.
- 1973. 7. 1.** 대통령령 제6543호(1973.3.12)로 금왕면을 읍으로 승격하여 2읍 7면이 됨.

## History

**A long time ago Eumseong was a Jin kingdom field and kingdom which was in the midst of the 50 kingdoms of the three Han era.**

**The era of the three kingdom was called Inghol Hyeon.**

**We believe the first nor then area was named Noeumjuk-Hyeon (The seat was at the present site of Gyeong-gi do, I-cheon gun, Jang-ho-won eup, Seon-eup ri) after that it was named Geummulno gun(now Jin-cheon)**

- 661~680** Eumseong county was Inghol hyeon belonged to the Seowonkyeong (now Cheongju) during the reign of king Munmu of Silla kingdom.
  
- 757.** The name Inghol hyeon was changed to Eumseong hyeon in the 16th year of the accession to the throne of king Gyeongdeok of the Silla kingdom.
  
- 995.** Eumseong hyeon become Jungwon do. Chungju bu, Eumseong hyeon in the 14th year of the accession to the throne of king seongjong of the Korea kingdom
  
- 1356.** Eumseong hyeon become yanggwang do. Chungju bu, Eumseong hyeon in the 5th year of the accession to the throne of king Gongmin of the Korea kingdom.
  
- 1598.** Reorganized in to the Cheongan hyeon in the 31th year of the accession to the throne of Seonjo of the Yi dynasty.
  
- 1618.** Cheongan hyeon was rejoined with Eumseong hyeon in the 18th year of the accession to the throne of Gwanghae gun of the dynasty.
  
- 1662.** Eumseong hyeon was annexed to the Goesan gun in the 3rd year of the accession to the throne of hyeonjong of the Yi dynasty.
  
- 1663.** Again reorganized to the Eumseong hyeon in the 4th year of the accession to the throne of Hyeonjong of the dynasty.

## History

- 1895. 5.26.** Royal edict No. 98. for appellation Eumseong gun(county)
- 1914. 3. 1.** Ordinance No. 111. of the government.(1913.12.29. Proclamation) Soi myeon(township) of Chungju gun(county). Geunwang myeon, Saenggeuk myeon, Daeso myeon, Maengdong myeon, Somseong myeon, Gamgok myeon, was absorbed as aboliton and amalgamation government county-township, therefore becoming 9 township.
- 1956. 7. 8.** Legislation No. 393.  
Eumseong myeon was elvated to Eumseong eup 1 eup (town) 8 myeon (township)
- 1973. 7. 1.** A presidential decree No. 6542.(1973.12.12. proclamation) Dosin ri partially of Saenggeuk myeon was absorbed in to geumwang myeon. Gwangwol ri muse settlement beig partially of Sinni myeon of Jungwon gun in to Eumseong eup : and Mundeung ri in Buljeong myeon of goesan gun in to Soi myeon.
- 1973. 7. 1.** Presidential decree No. 6543. (1973. 3. 12. proclamation)  
Geumwong myeon was elevated to Geumwong eup.  
Therefore becoming 2 eup(town) 7 myeon(township)
